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





#### Preventable causes of death as a % by age group








# Location of fatal accidents, 20-64 year olds, England & Wales, 2012





Figure 7 – Rate of drownings by water and gender, inland waters














#### Causes of hospital admissions, by age group




### Preventable causes of hospital admissions as a %






#### **Emergency Department first attendances**



England 1987-2012 (NHS HSCIC sitreps data)






#### Estimated causes of A&E attendances by age group

6.5 million A&E attendances due to accidents (30% of attendances)





- Oxford University Hospitals Trust A&E departments:
  - John Radcliffe, Oxford
  - Horton General, Banbury
- Data recorded by A&E receptionists

- Data analysed by the Global Health, Policy and Innovation research group at Queen Mary, University of London
- Factors recorded
  - Age
  - o Gender (55% M, 45% F)
  - Injury & injury mechanism
  - Severity
  - Location of accident
  - Activity

NEW: Not otherwise routinely recorded by NHS A&E departments

1st Jan 2012 to 31st Dec 2012






## A&E attendances: severity & numbers by location



26,310 injuries 1st January 2012 to 13th August 2013











